## Writing

### Report.

This is the report regarding the new school canteen. I have interviewed multiple students, and therefore would like to provide the results.

First of all, all students have mentioned the improved interior of the canteen. Bigger windows allow more light to enter the room, making the atmosphere cozier and more welcoming. Some students have also pointed out the increased number of plants, saying it was a great step towards being more eco-friendly. Despite the fact that the canteen has become smaller, there haven't been any complaints regarding this matter.

When it came to the food, however, the opinions were mixed. The majority of the students have found the quality of the food satisfying, but the real reason behind a lot of complaints has been the lack of diversity and ignorance towards special needs. Around 30% of the students in our school come from various cultural backgrounds, from Indian to Swedish, and those students have found it offensive that there was no representation of their cuisines in the menu. Another group of people dissatisfied with the menu was vegetarians. They noted that the amount of food that did not contain meat or milk was so poor to choose from, and therefore requested more plant-based options.

The majority of the students have found the pricing policy quite fair. With different discounts and special prices given to minorities and low-income families, school

meals have become affordable to everyone. There has been a noticeable increase in the number of students having meals at school - in fact, those numbers have almost doubled since this policy was implemented.

Overall, I would call the changes positive, since the amount of negative feedback was quite small. However, some steps should be taken towards food diversity, such as introducing new dishes from other countries or making vegetarian versions of the served food. This way we can stop racism towards ~~make~~ national minorities and make the menu more interesting and diverse.
