Also, money which people pay to visit the museum ¹⁶⁰ can be used for charity. I had such a case in my life when ¹⁷⁰ I with my classmates and I went to ¹⁸⁰ an exhibition supported by a ¹⁹⁰ charity foundation and all the money visitors aid for entering the museum ²⁰⁰ were given to a local hospital later.

²¹⁰ In conclusion I'd like to admit that ²²⁰ advantages of admission charges don't outweigh the disadvantages, but it would be great if more museums which can afford ²³⁰ of taking admission charges became free.
